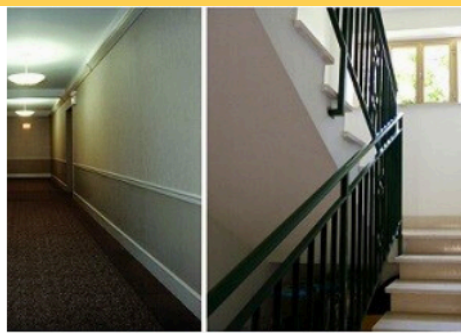
Dear Residents,

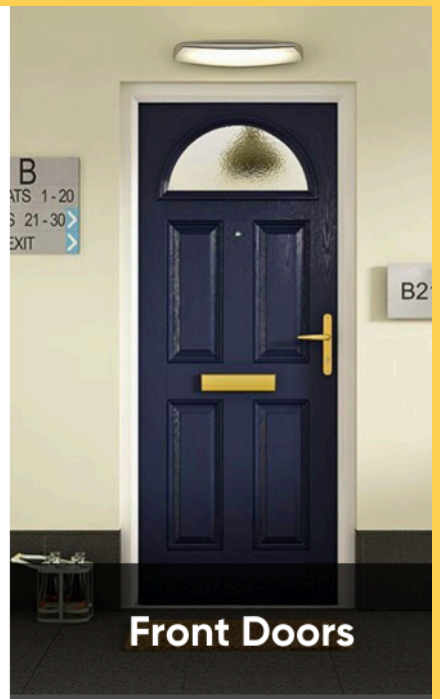

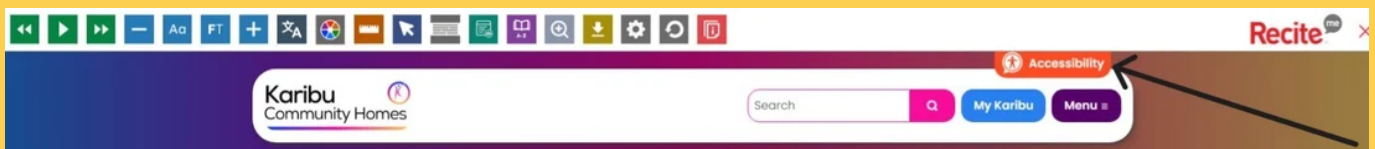

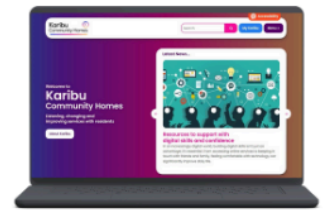
